## 👉 Welcome from the Head of School, **Pauline Amiel**

The Aix-Marseille School of Journalism and Communication (EJCAM) is a school of excellence for student, from third-year bachelor's degrees to professional master's degrees in 'Information and Communication' and 'Journalism'.

The master's degrees in communication cover the most promising sectors: digital communication, communication related to ecological transition, and event communication, for example. All these courses are available as initial and continuing education.

In order to respond to changes in the professional environment and new expectations in the job market, EJCAM has updated its educational programme since 2024. This update includes:

- the introduction of other work-study programmes,
- specialty tracks, now structured around several main areas: communication and media, communication and the environment, communication and marketing, and digital project management,
- the internationalisation of EJCAM, with the introduction of a digital communication programme taught mainly in English, offering new opportunities for students wishing to develop their skills in an English-speaking environment,
- the integration of courses dedicated to understanding the challenges of artificial intelligence into its programmes,
- the recruitment of highly specialised external instructors,
- the constant renewal of the technical resources available to students.

Studios dedicated to audiovisual production for social media and media training have been set up.

EJCAM's commitment to the advanced professionalisation of its teaching programmes is reflected in the confidence that companies place in our students. The employment rate for our students is 89% in journalism and 73% in communication.

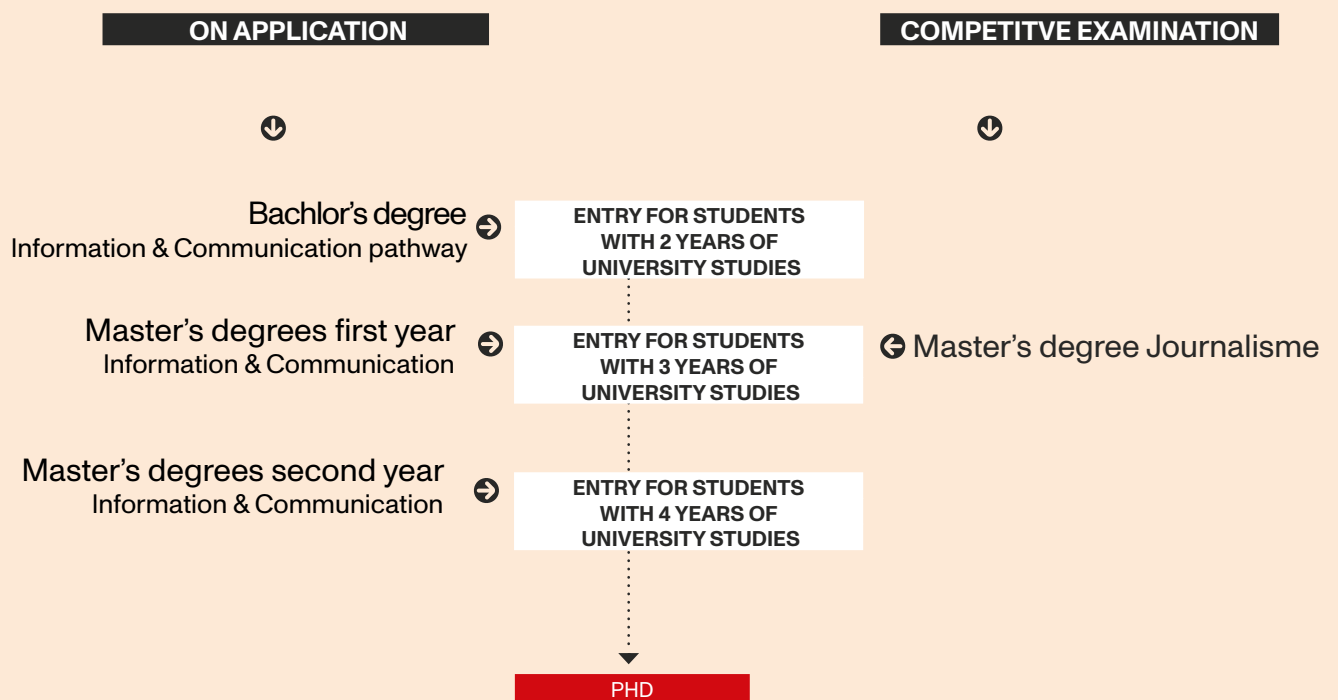

# MASTER'S DEGREE STRATEGIES OF COMMUNICATION & PRESS RELATIONS

AIX-EN-ENPROVENCE CAMPUS

This master's degree is based on a programme designed to complement periods spent in the workplace. It is organised around sessions that develop professional skills and attitudes in two areas:

- | Communication strategies, which are essential for versatility as a manager and/or communications officer.
- | Press relations, which are specific to the master's programme in communication, information and media.

## 🕒 Admission requirements

Admission to the first year is open to students with a bachelor's degree or equivalent, subject to review of their application. Direct admission to the second year is possible for students with a four-year degree, subject to review of their application.

Applicants undertake to seek a contract with a company, which is a necessary condition for enrolment in the programme. Admission is conditional upon obtaining such a contract.

## INFORMATION PROFESSIONS

AIX-EN-PROVENCE CAMPUS

The master's degree in Information Professions is a programme designed and delivered as part of a partnership between the Institut d'Etudes Politiques d'Aix-en-Provence and the Aix-Marseille School of Journalism and Communication.

Two options are available:

| Communication, Influence and Advocacy

This option focuses primarily on influential communication and strategic support for public affairs departments.

This option provides expertise in editorial issues within multimedia newsrooms and in an international context.

# MASTER'S DEGREE

## JOURNALISM

MARSEILLE CAMPUS

The master's degree in Journalism, recognised by the profession, is organised over two years. It trains journalists to work in a variety of media (print and digital press, television and radio).

Students acquire both solid professional and technical skills, as well as in-depth knowledge of contemporary issues and the media environment.

Admission to the Master's programme is by open competition, with no age limit, to all holders of a Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification.
